Gospel Reading John 10:11-18

The Living Christ says,

"I – I am the Shepherd, the Good One. The Shepherd, the Good One, lays down his soul for the sheep. But the one who is just hired – and not the shepherd and so does not own the sheep – sees the wolf coming and releases the sheep and flees away. And the wolf seizes them and scatters them. The hired person flees because he is just hired and does not care about the sheep. I – I am the Shepherd, the Good One. And I know my own and my own know me. Just as the Father knows me, so I know the Father. And I lay down my soul for the sheep. Other sheep I have, which are not of this enclosure. Them also I must lead. And they shall hear my voice. And there shall be one flock, one Shepherd. Through this Self the Father loves – because I lay down my soul in order to receive it anew. No one takes it from me, but I lay it down freely, from myself. I have the inner freedom and power to lay it down. And I have the inner freedom and power to received from my Father."

Silence as Centering Prayer

Silence is a Way to Love, a path and practice that enables us to love. In Silence as Centering Prayer we are asking for Love, to be centered in Love, to be able to receive and also give Love. We begin by asking with our own body, sensing our own body here and now. We descend into the region of the heart, with our attention directed towards our heart. From this place, we breathe deeply and pray. If it helps, use a sacred word to help you descend into this silence (such as Beloved, Shalom, Shepherd, Mercy, Abba, Jesus, or Spirit) or a breath prayer, such as "Lord" (inhale) "have mercy" (exhale). If a thought, feeling, or sensation tries to take you away from this interior place, don't "hold on" to it – simply and gently release it by returning to your sacred word or breath prayer.
