Sitting with Scripture

Romans 8:14-17

For all who are led by the Ruach Elohim (the Spirit of God), these are children of God. For you did not receive the spirit of slavery to fall again into fear; rather, you received the Spirit of adoption, by whom we cry, "Abba! Father!" The Ruach Itself bears witness with our spirit that we are children of God. And if children, also heirs — heirs of God and joint-heirs with the Christ — if indeed we suffer with Him so that we may also be glorified with Him.

Centering in the Silence

Relax. Sense your body. Breathe deeply. If it helps, use a sacred word to help you descend into this silence (such as Ruach, Abba, Jesus, Love, or Mercy) or a breath prayer, such as "Here" (inhale) "I am" (exhale).
