



Offering Our Psalm-Prayer

Psalm 133 (from *Psalms for a Pilgrim People*)

At oases on the pilgrim way we rest together, sharing the stories and meals that refresh us.

Sitting in Gratitude

Silence

During these minutes of silence, simply rest in God's abiding and loving presence in this moment. Simply be here now. You are in the Love of God. Christ is your Divine Center. If it helps you to center, use a sacred prayer word such as Mercy, Love, Abba, Jesus, or Spirit. Or follow the rhythm of your breath.
