

A Discerning Heart: Listening to Jesus

In Aramaic and in all the Semitic languages, the word for "good" primarily means ripe, and the word for "corrupt" or "evil" primarily means unripe.

When heard with Aramaic ears, those words [in Luke 6:43] might sound more like this:

"A ripe tree brings forth ripe fruit, an unripe tree brings forth unripe fruit."

This makes a world of difference. The tree is not morally bad, but rather unripe:

this is not the right time and place for it to bear.

The saying gives an example from nature. Rather than imposing an external standard of goodness, the lesson has to do with time and place, setting and circumstance, health and disease.
