You might use a breath prayer to help you descend into this silence at the level of the heart, such as "You" (inhale), "are here" (exhale), or use a sacred word (such as Love, Peace, Beloved, Abba, Jesus, or Spirit).

"Saints & Pilgrims: A Pilgrimage along the Coast of East England" October 16-27, 2023
