A Guide for Prayer

Tending the Fruit of Wisdom

I do not ask for wealth or fame, Endless riches, great acclaim. I ask for one thing in your name: Grant me a discerning heart.

Beyond the knowledge I have learned, All experiences earned, See wisdom waits to be affirmed, Held in a discerning heart.

Resting in the Silence

During these 5 minutes of silence, simply rest in God's abiding and loving presence in this moment. Simply be here now. Descend into this Silence. There is nothing you need to do. Just relax. Sense your body. Breathe more deeply than usual. It can help to focus on the region of the heart. You might use a breath prayer to help you descend into this silence at the level of the heart, such as "May my mind" (inhale), "be as Your Mind" (exhale), or use a sacred word (such as Love, Peace, Abba, Jesus, or Spirit).
