



Contemplating Scripture

You have The Anointing from the Holy One, and you are discerning all things. I have not written to you because you do not know The Truth, but because you know the Truth....

Allow the One you have heard from The Beginning to abide in you. For if the One you have heard from The Beginning abides in you, you will abide in the Son and in the Abba.

And this is the Promise that he has promised to us – The Eternal Life.

But these things I have written to you, because of those who lead you astray.

And if The Anointing, which you have received from him, abides in you, you have no need that anyone teach you. For the same Anointing, which is from Alaha, teaches you concerning All Things and is Truth and is not False. Just as It has taught you, you shall abide in him.

Contemplating Scripture

1 John 2:3-6,9-11

And by this we know that we know him – if we keep his commandments. For the one who says, "I know him," and does not keep his commandments, is false, and The Truth is not in this one.

But the one who keeps his Word, in this one the Love of God is truly perfected. In this we know that in him we are.

The one who says, "I abide in him," ought to walk according to his "walkings."

The one who says, "I am in the Light," but hates his sibling, is in the Darkness until now. The one who loves his sibling abides in the Light, and there is no stumbling block in him. But the one who hates his sibling, in the Darkness he is, and in the Darkness he walks, and he does not know where he goes, because the Darkness has blinded his eyes.

Or follow the rhythm of your breath.
