Contemplating Scripture

1 John 3:1-3, 21-24

Behold how great is the Love of the Abba towards us, that he has called us, "Sons," and made us so.
Therefore, the World does not know us, because it does not know him.

My beloved, now we are the Sons of God, and it is not yet manifest what we shall be. But we know that when he is manifested, we are in his likeness, and we shall see him as he is. And all who have this hope upon him purify themselves, just as he is pure....

My beloved, if our heart does not disdain us, we have confidence before the Divine.
And whatever we ask, we receive from him, because we keep his commandments and bring forth the things which are beautiful before him.

And this is his Commandment, that we trust in the Name of his Son, Yeshua the Anointed One, and love one another, just as he gave a commandment to us.
