

Contemplating Scripture

We have believed and have known the Love which God has towards us. For God is Love. And whoever abides in Love, abides in God.

By this Love is completed in us, that we might have openness of face in the Day of Judgment. Because as he is, so also are we in this world.

In Love there is no fear, but perfect, fully formed Love casts fear outside, because those who fear are those in danger. So the one who fears in not perfected – fully formed – in Love.

We therefore love God, because he aforetime loved us.

Meditation

Song of Response God in my words, God in my hands. God in my mind and in my heart.

Silence

During these minutes of silence, simply rest in God's abiding and loving presence in this moment. You are in God and God is in you. Just be and relax. Center your attention in your heart and imagine your breath flowing in and out from your heart area. If it helps you to center, use a sacred prayer word such as Christ, Love, Abba, Jesus, or Spirit. Or follow the rhythm of your breath.
